Please include a brief biographical note indicating your qualifications for reviewing the work in question in your submission.

Review guidelines:

- Reviews should typically be 750–1000 words in length. We may also publish longer review essays—please send proposals for these to the Book Review Editor.
- Reviews should assess the strengths and weaknesses of the book and locate it within the current field of scholarship.
- Reviews should be written in clear and concise prose and addressed to a broad interdisciplinary readership of scholars.
- Reviews should use US punctuation and spelling.
- Transliteration should follow the Library of Congress system.
- Do not include footnotes or bibliography in your review.
- Please include the book details at the beginning of the review, using the following format:
Author /Editor Name. Title. Place of publication: Publisher, Year.
Number of pages.
- Please provide your full name and institutional affiliation, or city, at the end of the review.

Deadlines: for the April issue: 15 December; for the October issue: 15 June.
